


STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS



Q1. In what manner you see to estimate the course manifesto that are illuminated in the curriculum?




Q2. In what way do you amount the disposal of commissioned hours amid the course structure?



Q3. In what manner do you assay the input in affiliation to physical world applications?







Q4. In what way do you evaluate the approach of elective course in terms of their implication to the gaining in-depth knowledge of streams?


Q5. Scale the curriculum in terms of additional learning or self-learning in view of the proposal of modules.






Q6. Scale the curriculum in terms of categorization of approach in view of whether the prior modules have been ensconced.



Q7. Scale the curriculum in terms of weigh down on the apprentice.




Q8. Are the books prescribed as a textbook/ Reference book related to the syllabus?






Q10. Whether syllabus is relevant to real word problems
